Full Job Description

Maritime is looking for a Scale Attendant to work as part of our Hammerdown team to support the construction of our Hammerdown Project near King's Point. This position offers a unique opportunity to contribute to bringing the province's next gold mine into production.

Reporting to the Operations Manager, this position will play a critical role in supporting the Hammerdown Gold Project. You will be responsible for supporting ore transportation from the Hammerdown site by operating the truck weigh scales to ensure accurate weights of trucks and ore cargo at the Hammerdown Mine site. This position also serves as a point of contact for drivers and assists with the direction of site transport and light vehicle traffic. This position requires an ability to collect and manage data and other related documentation, use of computers and other electronic equipment.

Key Functions:

- Operate scale system by accurately weighing all highway transport trucks and materials, and ensuring correct documentation is recorded and maintained.
- Act as the first point of contact for truck drivers, providing professional and efficient service and information.
- Support site operations by helping to manage site traffic and workflow at the scale house.
- Provide clear communication to truck drivers and customers at the scale house.
- Conduct general inspections of the truck weigh scales and note any corrective actions or concerns.
- Other duties as assigned.
